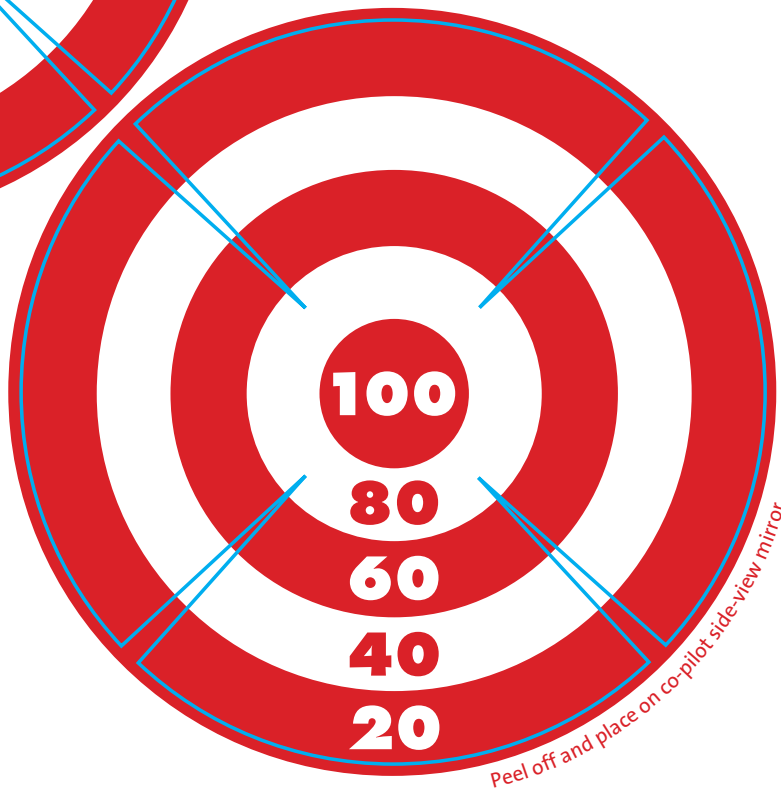
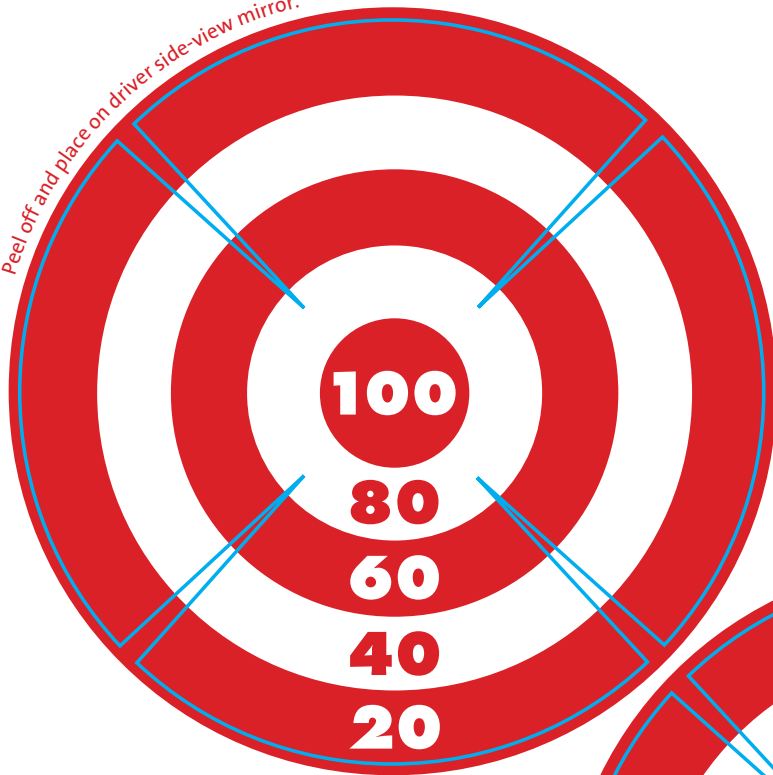

RULES & REGULATIONS. Anyone with a valid driver's license can play. If any part of the bug (splatter or body part) touches multiple scoring zones, the higher score should be tallied. Players must set own time, distance and limit of bug hits before starting a new game. Remember to obey all local driving laws and wildlife preservation acts. Hitting an endangered insect constitutes immediate forfeiture (see below for reference). The death or dismemberment of any butterfly is also grounds for disqualification (and a moment of silence would be nice).
